Program Eligibility

We review all applications holistically and do not have a GPA requirement. Competitive applicants typically meet the following:

- Currently enrolled as a junior in high school
- Primarily A's in the most challenging courses offered at a student's high school
- Highly ranked amongst graduating class
- Planning to apply to college during senior year
- SAT or PSAT score of 1250+ / ACT or Pre-ACT score of 26+ (if available)
- Actively engaged in school community and/or community more generally
- Household annual income at or below \$75,000
- Identify as a student of color and/or first-generation college goer
- A commitment to our residential six week Summer Academy

Application Timeline

Our two staged application timeline is outlined below. Students who advance to Round Two will be notified in mid-late January.

November 30, 2022 Priority Application Deadline

December 15, 2022 General Application Deadline

- Mid-late January 2023 Round Two Advancement
- Mid-February 2023 Round Two Submission
